

# ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION

Persons who are unable to attend their regular polling place on Election Day, or want to vote early, may vote by absentee ballot prior to Election Day.

Absentee ballots for the Primary Election, August 11, 2020, will be available at the Itasca County Auditor's Office beginning Friday, June 26, 2020. The Auditor's office may not issue or send ballots to a voter until an application on a prescribed form is filed in this office, either in person, email, fax or through the mail. Applications to receive an absentee ballot are available in the Auditor's Office Monday through Friday, 8 AM to 4:30 PM or on the MN Secretary of State's website under "Absentee Voting." All voted ballots must be received in person by 3:00 PM on Election Day (August 11, 2020) OR be postmarked by Election Day and received by the Itasca County Auditor's Office by 4:30 PM on August 13, 2020, or they will not be counted.
