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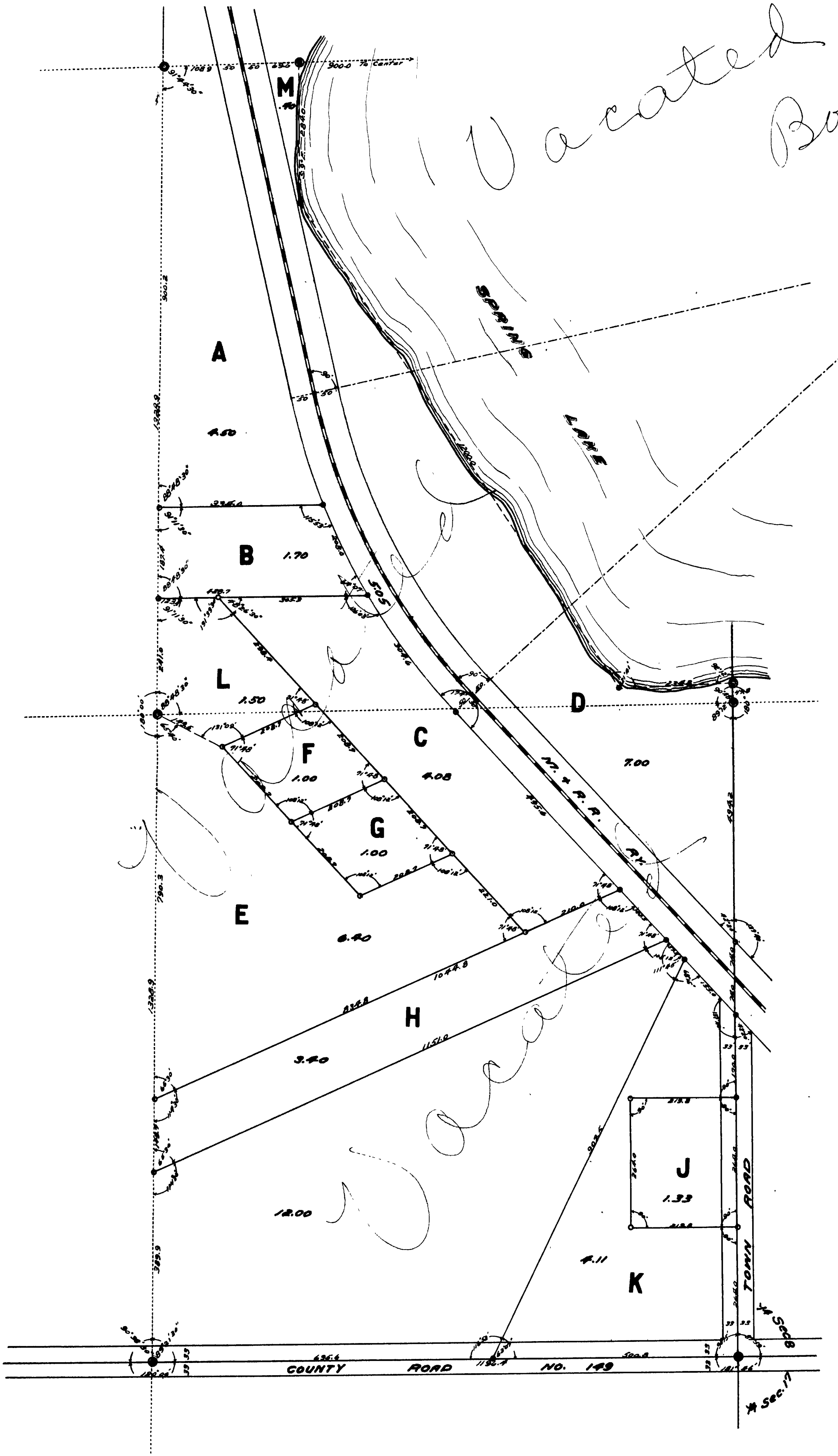
AUDITOR'S SUBDIVISION OF SPRING LAKE

 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, and this is to certify that I, Frank Sherman, as County Auditor in and for the County of Itasca, and State of Minnesota, have been such Auditor at all times herein mentioned; that the following described Tracts and Lots of Land, to-wit:

The East half (E½) of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of Section Eight (8), Township One Hundred Forty-eight (148) North, Range Twenty-five (25), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, and more accurately described as follows:

Beginning at the West 1-16 Corner of Secs. 8 and 17 of Township 148, North Range 25, West of the Fifth Principal Meridian; thence North on 1-16 line a distance of 2657.3 feet, to the 1-16 Corner between the Northwest Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of Section 8; thence East at an angle from the South to East of 91 deg. 44 min. 20 sec. a distance of 278.5 feet, to the Meander Corner on the ¼ line; thence South 9 deg. East a distance of 284.0 feet; thence South 33 deg. 53 min. East, a distance of 1200.0 feet; thence South 87 deg. 48 min. East, a distance of 284.8 feet to the Meander Corner on the ½ line; thence South on the ½ line a distance of 1340.2 feet to the ¼ Corner of Sec. 8 and 17; thence West at an angle of 90 deg. 15 min. from North to West, a distance of 1196.4 feet along the Section line between Secs. 8 and 17, to the point of beginning, is divided into parcels of irregular shape, which cannot be described except by metes and bounds;

that on the 13th day of February, 1918, I, as said Auditor, duly requested owners of said tracts of land, to-wit: O. E. Hulehan, Earl Gorman, School District No. 6, A. F. Heid, A. Ludgate, Ed Jury, S. Bergstrom, and Jameson Bros., to have such tracts of land platted into lots, as required by section nine hundred ninety one (991), of the Revised Laws of Minnesota, 1905; that said owners having failed so to do within thirty (30) days after such request, I did, on the 20th day of March, 1918, as provided by said Statute, duly request the duly qualified and acting Surveyor of said Itasca County, Minnesota, to make such Plat from the Records of the Register of Deeds, in and for said County, and to make and certify to the necessary survey and Plat; that as appears from the certificate of the said County Surveyor filed herewith said Plat has been made by him and returned to me, as said Auditor; that this plat is presented hereby, to the Register of Deeds in and for said County of Itasca, State of Minnesota, for filing and for record.

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority of my said office and pursuant to the Statute in such case made and provided, to-wit: Section Nine Hundred and Ninety one (991) of the Revised Laws of Minnesota, 1905, I do hereby ratify and confirm, and establish this Plat, the same to be henceforth known as "Auditor's Subdivision of Spring Lake," and do hereby confirm and dedicate to the Public, forever, all the highways, streets, roads, alleys, and byways, delineated.
